

Social Distancing and Sanitary Protocols for 2020 Sailing Season

Students will -

- 1. Affirm they are free of any/all symptoms of COVID-19, affirm they have not been in contact with anyone diagnosed with COVID-19 in the past 14 days, and recognize the possible risk of exposure to COVID-19.
- 2. Be required to bring his or her own face covering that must be worn when in close proximity to another sailor or staff member.
- 3. Students will bring their own clearly labeled lifejacket, water, lunch and any other necessary equipment needed.

On-site protocol for students and instructors -

- 1. Cover face and sanitize hands at on-site dispenser before stepping onto the dock.
- 2. Students will keep their water bottle, jacket, etc. in a plastic bag in a sanitized crate stored in the SCSS boathouse.

All parties recognize the risk that comes from participating in activities with the SCSS and will not hold the SCSS liable for any injury or sickness sustained while participating in said activities.
